

TAB 6: Project Amenities/Services

Residents of The Beury Building will have the opportunity to meet with the North City Congress Services Coordinator periodically for a holistic needs assessment. This assessment considers physical, emotional, mental, spiritual, and social health. Residents, their families, and North City Congress' staff will collaborate to define a service plan, which will link each resident to a diverse array of services and products, including:

- Assistive devices such as additional bars, raised toilet seat with bars, shower chairs, etc.
- In-home health support such as nursing, physical therapy, personal care, and housekeeping
- Assistive technology such as phones for persons who are hearing-, vision-, or speech-impaired
- Medical alert system
- Medication machines
- Legal services
- Transportation
- Meals
- Other resources including support groups, books on tape or in Brail, specialized exercise programs targeted to particular disabilities, etc.

In addition, each apartment will be Visitable, many apartments will feature roll-in showers and adaptable baths and kitchens to support aging in place, and every unit will have immediate access within the building to over 40,000 square feet of community wellness services.
