Enclosed please find one original and seven hard copies plus an electronic copy on a USB drive of the above-referenced proposal.

Liberty Housing Development Corporation (LHDC) is requesting up to \$96,000 per year of operating subsidy, an average of \$500 per unit per month for 16 units, in support of its Liberty52: Community Integration project. LHDC will create 24 permanent supportive housing units for disabled and elderly adults. On-site and off-site comprehensive case management and supportive services will be provided. It will also create community-based living opportunities for disabled adults who seek to move out of nursing homes and into accommodations in which they can live independently. Please note that we submitted an application for 8 project based vouchers in the RFP round that closed on September 30<sup>th</sup> and remain hopeful as we await a response.

We appreciate PHA's willingness to consider our request. ACC support at the level requested will enable LHDC to serve disabled and elderly residents in their community.
