


### Estimated percent of people with one or more disabilities between 2008-2012.

Estimated percent of the civilian noninstitutionalized population with one or more types of disabilities between 2008-2012. Percentage calculations were suppressed in cases where the denominator of the calculation was less than 10 of the unit that is being described (e.g., households, people, householders, etc). Such areas are represented as having "Insufficient Data" in the map. Denominators for percentage calculations were created by summing all of the component data items in a particular dataset. These data are mapped to the 2010 Census boundaries.


