

## 10. SUPPORTIVE SERVICE PLAN

As a project serving senior residents aged 62 and older, Greater Bible Way Senior Apartments is going to provide all tenants with a wide range of supportive services to help them live independently and to facilitate aging in place. For many years, the Temple has been providing the local community with various services aimed at the neediest neighbors. The Temple will expand this range of services into a comprehensive supportive services plan serving the future residents of the development and beyond, including but not limited to:

- **Emergency Food Cupboard:** The Temple partners with the SHARE Food Program to distribute food to financially disadvantaged families in the neighborhood. Any tenants at the new development who choose to enroll in the program will receive food assistance from the Emergency Food Cupboard.
- **Transportation:** Currently transportation is provided to help senior members of the community travel to their doctor's appointments, get groceries and participate in some other community activities and events. This transportation service will be expanded to accommodate future senior residents at the development, even though many amenities will also be provided on-site.
- **Homemaker/housekeeping assistance:** this volunteer-based program has volunteers come to the houses of seniors in the community to assist them with cleaning, cooking and keeping up their homes. The church plans to expand this meaningful program to the development, not only to help tenants with their chores but also to promote social interactions and a sense of community for seniors.

- Social activities and community events: the Temple organizes social gatherings on special occasions and on a quarterly basis to bring the community together. The community space and courtyard at this proposed development will serve as a great venue for future events that benefit both the residents and the wider community.
- On-site health checkup: the building is designed with a health suite on the first floor. The developers are working to identify a local health care provider which will locate a health office on site to provide residents with regular health check-ups and medical advice, helping the senior residents age in place.
